ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Applicant must be a Sonoma County resident pursuing a career in the agriculture or Ag related field.
- 2. Applicant must have graduated from El Molino High School, were enrolled for a minimum of two years in agriculture classes and maintained an agriculture project **OR** must be a graduating senior student at West County High after attending El Molino High School and been actively enrolled in agriculture while at El Molino and West County. Must have been an active FFA member.
- 3. Applicant must be entering or attending a university or college, community college or accredited trade school as a full-time student (minimum 12 units).
- 4. Scholarships may be awarded to an individual more than one time.

APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

- 1. The completed application
- 2. All high school transcripts if you are applying as a graduating senior-unofficial
- 3. All college transcripts if you are applying as a continuing college student unofficial
- 4. Two (2) letters of recommendation from someone aware of your agriculture experiences:
- May be from a 4-H Leader, FFA Advisor or a person in the agriculture industry

Note: Parents, guardians, or close relatives or may not write a letter of reference.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The scholarship application will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- 1. Show promise in achieving agricultural career goal.
- 2. Financial need.
- 3. Average scholarship achievement (minimum C average).
- 4. Must demonstrate leadership and community service.

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1. Completed applications must be mailed with a postmark no later than May 30th, 2022 to the El Molino Ag Boosters, P.O. Box 1418, Forestville, CA 95436. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. Please make sure you send to the correct address.
- 2. The El Molino Ag Booster Scholarship Committee will evaluate applications and select the recipient(s) based upon the criteria. Decision by the committee shall be final. Recipient will be notified by e-mail.
- **3.** The scholarship money will not be presented until proof of full-time enrollment in a college or university, community college or trade/business school has been mailed to the El Molino Ag Boosters at P.O. Box 1418, Forestville, CA 95436. **Verifications must be received by November 1, 2022 or scholarship will be forfeited**
